Located in the heart of Central Texas, Kyle is a charming community situated between Austin and San Antonio. IH-35 and MoPac Rail Line, sometimes called the "Backbone of America", are major transportation arteries that run through the middle of Kyle.

Education

Located in North central Hays County, the Hays Consolidated Independent School District serves over 209 square miles. Parts of the district extend into southeastern Travis County and into western Caldwell County. The district currently has 22 campuses. The Hays Consolidated I.S.D. is an Academically Acceptable district by TEA.

Hays CISD is a rapidly growing district. Sixty-five percent of Hays High School students take SAT or ACT exams, and 60 percent of the school's graduates are accepted to college. Students have access to a wide variety of career and technology courses from networking and business computer information systems to electronics and graphic design. Every campus has at least one certified librarian, certified counselor, and full-time registered nurse. Every classroom has Internet access. The district provides special education support for students who need assistance and Advanced Placement courses for students who show aptitude. The Hays CISD also offers extensive academic and athletic extra curricular activities. Both individual students and teams successfully compete at the highest level of competition.
