Regional Information

Pflugerville is located 13 miles northeast of Downtown Austin, bordering Austin's City Limits on the south and Round Rock on the north, Pflugerville's current City Limits encompass an area of about 25 square miles and lies at the intersection of state highways 45 and 130 and is 2 miles east of Interstate I-35 in northeast Travis County.

Education

The mission of Pflugerville Independent School District is to provide a quality education with a commitment to excellence by facilitating learning in a safe and nurturing environment.

Recreation

The Pflugerville Recreation Center is a multi-use facility, providing programs and quality instruction to all participants. Use of the facility is by membership only, one year, 3 month, or daily passes are offered. Programs and classes are offered on a per session basis. Some programs and classes will change periodically, while others will remain constant. Membership not required to participate in classes. Adult sports leagues (men's basketball, coed volleyball) are also offered.

The members of the Pflugerville Parks and Recreation Department, are dedicated to providing the citizens of Pflugerville with opportunities for increased health and wellness through recreational activities and safe park facilities that promote physical, emotional, intellectual, cultural and social well-being for all members of the community.

Quality of Life

Pflugerville is committed to families. Located minutes from technology giants Dell, Samsung, Motorola and IBM, the city attracts a highly educated population in search of quality housing, excellent schools and a safe, health environment.

Accessibility is also a factor. Pflugerville is located just 20 minutes from Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. And with two new state highways traversing the city, Pflugerville will soon be an essential hub for people making their way in and around Central Texas.

Pflugerville Attractions:

Pfluger Park

Pfluger Park located in the heart of downtown Pflugerville, is the perfect family gathering place. The City's Hike and Bike Trail loops around the Park and Gilleland Creek, with picnic tables and BBQ grills along the way. The Park has restrooms, a basketball court, sand volleyball court, and a playscape. Located in Pfluger Park, next to the playscape, is Pfluger Grove. This area consists of a covered gazebo, concrete tables and benches, a BBQ pit, and a grill. 515 City Park Road.

Gilleland Creek Park

The covered pavilion at Gilleland Creek Park has lights, picnic tables, BBQ pit, grill, and electricity. The park area has a small playscape and the hike and bike trail crosses Gilleland Creek which runs parallel to the pavilion. Gilleland Creek Park also encompasses a Jr. Olympic size swimming pool, Gilleland Creek Pool. 700 Railroad Avenue.

Scott B. Mentzer Pool

Heritage Park will feature the Scott B. Mentzer Recreation Pool. Scott Mentzer came to the parks department first as a camper, enrolled in our summer fun camp program for 4 years, and then as a camp counselor for 7 years. Scott was a school teacher at Windermere Elementary School before his sudden death at the age of 24. Scott loved children, local parks, and had a spirit and positive attitude about him that will live on in this new facility.

The new Park has been in the planning stages for several years. The Park will cost 2.6 million dollars at completion. The City of Pflugerville used a combination of bond money, developer contributions, Deutschen Pfest funds and a matching grant from the State Energy Conservation Office for a renewable energy demonstration project. Electricity for the barn and lighting for the trail will be provided from solar and wind power.

The pool will feature a slide and other interactive water features. Other amenities at the park will include a hike and bike trail, basketball court, bocce ball court, sand volleyball court, picnic shelter, barn, pond and nature trail, and an orchard.
