Education

"Access to quality education" is a common response, when residents are asked why they moved to Round Rock. Test scores at the Round Rock Independent School District rank among the elite in public education and twelve schools in the district have been named National Blue Ribbon Schools.

Along with the economic growth that Round Rock has experienced over the last decade, the Round Rock Independent School District has seen its student enrollment surpass 34,000. The 2010 Accountability Rating System ranked Round Rock ISD as a Recognized district with 25 of its schools being rated exemplary, 16 rated recognized and 3 being Academically Acceptable.

For those seeking higher and continuing education, Round Rock is conveniently located near several major universities, including the prestigious University of Texas at Austin. Round Rock is also very proud of the Round Rock Higher Education Center, which offers baccalaureate and advanced degrees within its city limits.

The Texas A&M Health Science expanded its programmatic offerings to Williamson County with the opening of its Round Rock campus in 2009, giving students an opportunity to pursue professional healthcare degrees in medicine, nursing & pharmacy education. After five years in the Double-A Texas League and one league championship, the Express continued its success with a move to the Triple-A Pacific Coast League for the 2005 season.

In its first Triple-A season, the Express earned a nomination for the Larry MacPhail Award for outstanding promotional work. The Dell Diamond has been named the Playing Surface of the Year six times and was voted by ESPN Outdoor as one of the top ballparks in the country. Round Rock has welcomed more than 4.7 million fans to The Dell Diamond since opening its gates. In its very first season in 2000, the Express became the most popular sports activity in Central Texas, drawing more fans to the Dell Diamond than the University of Texas football team attracted to Royal Memorial Stadium. Its ability to combine modern entertainment, sincere community involvement and a true traditional baseball atmosphere has made the Round Rock Express the prototype for a successful AA & AAA baseball franchise.

"What's really remarkable this year is that we have moved up a spot even though we are the second fastest-growing city in the country and in the midst of a recession, both of which tend to increase crime rates.
